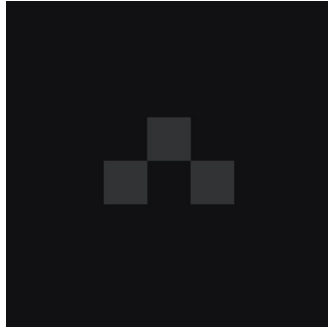
Global M&A Insurance: Considerations for Cross-Border Transactions

As Representations and Warranties Insurance (“RWI”) has become more of an industry norm in the United States, parties have increasingly sought to utilize U.S.-style RWI policies for cross-border transactions.
